Amboy Marsh/Gremel Wildlife Sanctuary

Amboy Marsh Nature Preserve, a 302-acre wetland complex, was purchased by the Illinois Audubon Society in 2012. The adjacent 395-acre Gremel Wildlife Sanctuary was purchased by the Illinois Audubon Society from Augustana College in Rock Island, Illinois. Our Master Naturalist volunteers have assisted with restoration efforts, including invasive species removal and numerous bird counts, as well as wildlife photography. They have also assisted in producing interpretive materials about the preserve.
