

Starved Rock State Park

Starved Rock State Park is located in LaSalle County along the south bank of the Illinois River. The Park attracted over 2 million visitors in 2018. Volunteers assist the Park in many ways including acting as information desk help, manning the visitor's center book store, leading interpretive hikes, and assisting with the restoration and maintenance of native plant beds located at the visitor's center. Volunteers also regularly assist at Park events including the Eagle Watch Weekend hosted by the Illinois Audubon Society.
