#### **Master Naturalist State** Conference - Monticello

Master Naturalist volunteers and coordinators from across the state met in Monticello at the 4-H Memorial Camp on October 25 to network and continue to expand their knowledge.

The day kicked off with a kevnote talk on mushrooms of Illinois by Dr. Andrew Miller with the INHS. Networking and lunch were followed by three concurrent sessions. Master Naturalists learned about native trees, managing invasive species, archaeology, grass identification, climate change, citizen science opportunities, and interpretation skills, among others!

Master Naturalists also had the opportunity to attend one of four pre-conference tours on October 24, such as birding at Allerton Park or learning about the history, natural areas, and gardens of Allerton Park.
