HANDS: List any service activities or leadership related to your horse project or 4-H. Be sure to include offices held, committee membership, or other horse project related service activities such as working at a 4-H horse show, setting up a horse farm visit, etc.

HEALTH: Describe something you learned or experienced that relates to horse health. This could be caring for your horse's injury/illness, visiting a veterinary clinic, doing a horse science project relating to health, etc. Be specific about what you learned and how.
