- The **Outstanding 4-H Club Vice-President Award** will be presented to the winners at the annual 4-H Achievement Celebration in the fall. The winning officer will be selected by nonpartisan judges based on information included in this form. The judges' decision will be final. Nomination forms become the property of the Ogle County Extension Office upon submission.
- Both 4-H Members and leaders can make nominations.
- A maximum of two winners will be recognized at the county 4-H Achievement Day.
- Winners will be those individuals who appear to have done the most effective job of carrying out the role of Vice-President based on the content in documents submitted.
- In order to be considered for judging, you must submit the following in a sealed envelope with your name written in ink across the seal. They should be submitted for judging unopened:
 1. This Award Application with leader signatures
 2. Attached Letter of Recommendation to be completed by a club member (not immediate family) addressing the questions below
 3. Attached Letter of Recommendation to be completed by the leader who works most closely with the officer team (not immediate family) addressing the questions below.
