All STEAM Clothing and non-clothing (sewn and non-sewn) and Shopping in Style project exhibits are judged prior to the 4-H Fair on Tuesday, July 12 at the Lillie M Evans Library in Princeville, IL. STEAM Clothing and Shopping in Style projects are not judged at the 4-H Fair, but are required to be on display at the 4-H Fair. Livestock Project Release

For 2022 all livestock will be released at the conclusion of their show. All livestock exhibitors must have a release form for every species they exhibit signed by the superintendent of that species before removing animals from the fairgrounds. Livestock exhibitors will be permitted to show out of their trailers for 2022.

Stalls will be available if needed but the exhibitor is responsible for the set up, take down and clean up of their stall area. Exhibitors are also responsible to bring their own equipment for the removal of debris for their animal.

If you have completed this certification, please send your certificate to <u>kristis2@illinoi.edu</u>. If you have not yet completed it, you will have to do the online version at <u>https://yqcaprogram.org</u>. If you are not YQCA certified, **you will not be allowed** to show. This is a State 4-H policy. For YQCA, you must be certified every year.

Have Fun and be Safe at the Fair

Providing a safe and fun learning experience for 4-H members is our number one goal for the 4-H show. With this in mind, we have a few helpful hints for you:

- **Reminder**—The road in front (south side) of the Beef, Jr. Livestock, Sheep & Swine livestock barns will be blocked off and accessible to load and unload livestock only. There will also be no parking in this area during the 4-H show to provide a safe environment for youth and other pedestrians in this busy walking area.
- In the event of a tornado or other severe weather everyone will be directed to take shelter in the restrooms adjacent to the snack bar area or the restrooms just outside (west side) of the youth building.
- For other emergencies such as a fire etc. everyone should meet in the snack bar area. Just like at home, we all need a meeting spot in case someone gets separated from their family.
- Youth are encouraged to use the buddy system when wandering the fair grounds. It's always a good idea to stay in the more populated areas but if youth are planning to go out front in the parking lot area, go with a friend.

- Include club name as part of display, meeting dates, times, location and leader contact info
- Display can either be a table display or a stall display in one of the livestock barns or something different. Please let the Extension office know in advance what type of display your club will have
- Set up can be done on early set up day, Monday, August 1, or Wednesday morning, August 3
- Judging will take place on Wednesday, and the winner will be announced Friday night at the beginning of the Clothing Review in the Youth Building
- 2022 Theme "Spark your Adventure in 4-H"
- Clubs are responsible for bringing all supplies
- Judges are looking for Creativity, Neatness, Eye Appeal, Use of Theme, Club Name and how 4-H is used in the display.

You also will want to remember to use this space for the club canned food drive! We want to provide healthy options for local food banks.

You have a shopping list for this! Any items on the shopping list will be worth five points. Items that are

<u>Early set up</u> – We will be setting up for the 4-H fair on Monday, August 1.

In the morning, we will clean and set up the youth building for project exhibits. If we have a lot of help, we should be done by 11:30 or noon, and will be serving pizza to our wonderful volunteers. In the late afternoon (approx.. 4:30-5 PM) we will start setting up the livestock barn stalls, rabbit pens, etc. We will have more pizza or hot dogs for our great late afternoon volunteers. (ALL youth exhibiting a livestock project are required to help set up stalls and/or pens. Please bring any necessary items you may need for set up. If you are unable to set up stalls or pens on this date, please contact the superintendent.



It's 4-H Fair Time!

Judging is a learning experience from which you can learn what you did well and how you could improve in the future. An exhibit does not measure all that you have learned, but it is an example of what you have done!

- 1. During conference judging, the judge will encourage you to talk about your project exhibit.
- You will be asked some questions about your exhibit, so be prepared to tell what you were trying to do in your project (goals & objectives) and be able to describe the methods and processes used to produce the exhibit.
- 3. Read and follow the rules and requirements for your project carefully. The rules and requirements are listed in the 4-H Show Book.
- 4. Learn and practice good sportsmanship.
- 5. Listen carefully to the judge so that you can accept constructive criticism, and learn from it.
- 6. Remember, judging comments can be helpful, but they are only one person's evaluation.
- 7. Realize that people sometimes make mistakes.
- 8. If you have any questions about a project exhibit rule or requirement, please call the Extension office at (309) 685-3140.
- 9. If parents have questions they would like to discuss with a 4-H judge, the question **MUST** go through an Extension staff member. Please do NOT approach a judge.


