All general projects selected for State Fair will be judged on **Saturday, August 9**. All projects must be checked in from 8 to 9:30 a.m. Project judging times will vary and will be available to you after project check-in. Other State Fair Judging dates include:

- July 21-27, 2025/ State Fair Junior Horse Show / Illinois State Fairgrounds
- October 4, 2025 / Illinois State 4-H Dog Show / Interstate Center, Arena B, Bloomington, IL

YQCA Reminder

The YQCA is the livestock quality assurance program that is required for youth in the following species: dairy cattle, beef cattle, swine, sheep, and goats. All 4-H exhibitors of these animals will be required to certify in the YQCA program yearly. Youth must either attend a face to face class or certify on-line via the website <u>yqcaprogram.org</u> The cost for face-to-face training is \$3 and \$12 for the online version.

Quality Assurance & Ethics:QA&E

The Quality Assurance and Ethics training is required for all youth that enroll in horses, rabbits, poultry, dogs, and cats. Members must take the training whether they own a live animal or not. Members only need to take this once during their 4-H career. The QAEC training can be accessed in the Clover Academy section of the ZSuite Enrollment System. ZSuite can be accessed at 4h.zsuite.org/. Families can access directions for completing the course at <u>go.illinois.edu/TakeQAEC</u>.

4-H Fair Reminders

- Attach your tag securely to your project
- Only projects with SF#### after the class name are eligible for State Fair delegates
- Trophy winners are asked to send a thank you to the trophy sponsor
- Animals must be in place by 7:30 AM on July 10 and 8 AM on July 11
- All animals must be show health papers before unloading
- Livestock exhibitors must wear appropriate footwear while in show ring. Appropriate show attire is recommended.
- Livestock is released at the end of the auction.
- Auction Guidelines are on page 10 of the show book.
- The Golden Pitchfork competition must be pre-registered, includes and interview, and is based on sportsmanship, responsibility, and showmanship.
- Showmanship Adventure is for goats, rabbits, and poultry. Details on on page 44 of show book.
- Master Showmanship is for beef, sheep, and swine. Details are on page 43 of show book.
