4-H Enrollments

Check with the Extension office to make sure you are enrolled in the right projects.

May 1, 2021 is the deadline for making changes (except for those livestock projects that had a January deadline). Young persons may join 4-H at any time of year, but to exhibit at the 4-H show they must be enrolled at the county Extension office by May 1 of each year.

To be a 4-H member in the 2020-2021 year, youth must be at least 8, and not more than 18 as of September 1, 2020. Cloverbuds must be at least age 5 by September 1, 2020.

With eSports becoming one of the largest growing tech industries in the world, with an annual revenue of \$1.5 billion with an expectation to reach \$2.2 billion by 2023, it is time that our youth become poised and ready to meet the demands of this growing field.

Are you at least 12 years old and own a computer or gaming system? This year Illinois 4-H released a pilot curriculum focused on the growing field of electronic sports, or eSports, and we would like to pilot it with you! As a pilot, we hope to add to and modify the curriculum based on the feedback and input of the youth involved. Under the direction of Illinois 4-H Computer Science Innovator Eric Li, youth will be virtually guided (using Zoom) through the eSports Pilot curriculum, learn the basics of the eSports field, and learn about the hardware and software that makes eSports possible. In addition, youth will be able to play and practice their favorite games as a team, and potentially compete in one or more eSports competitions through the Spring and Summer.

Registration for this opportunity will open on Dec. 1 and close on Jan. 15, with meetings beginning the third week of January. Schedule and goals will be determined/presented in the first meeting with plans on meeting at least twice a month (and more frequently before competitions).

2021 – Livestock Birth, Ownership and Tattoo Dates for Illinois State Fair Junior Show.

STEERS:

- Calved on or after January 1, 2020
- Owned & personally cared for by exhibitor since February 1, 2021

BARROWS: Regular Barrows

• Farrowed on or after January 1, 2021 and must be the property of the exhibitor by June 1, 2021. No weighing and tattooing required but must submit ear notches when making entry for county & ISF

BARROWS: Premiere Barrows

- **Farrowed on or after February 10, 2021** and must have been the property of the exhibitor by June 1, 2021
- Weighed and Tattooed with Box A tattoo from February 10 to April 15, 2021
- Tattooed within 35 days of birth and not weigh more than 1.0 lbs/day of age
- Junior exhibitors can purchase pre-nominated barrows

SHEEP Market Wethers & Market Ewe Lambs: Live Show Wethers –

No more Regional check-in sites – New nomination format

- Lambed on or after January 1, 2021
- Ownership Date May 15, 2021
- Self-nomination as follows: Nominations must be signed by local Extension Office.

Jr. and Open Premiere Wether & Ewe lambs: -

Weigh-in, tattoo, and nomination procedures:

- Junior and open premiere lambs will be nominated, tattooed, and weighed at the county level.
- Ownership and nomination deadline is March 15 to May 15, 2021. Lambed on or after January 1, 2021

Meat Goat Wethers: Live Show Wethers - No more Regional check-in sites - New nomination format

• Wethers – Born on or after October 1, 2020 Ownership dates for Kids & Yearlings not in milk – May 15, 2021

4-H Enrollment Deadlines

The following projects have a January 4, 2021 deadline. All other project enrollments and changes are due May 1, 2021.

- * Beef (for production animals)
- * Goat (for production animals)
- * Poultry (egg production)
- * Swine (for production animals)

- * Dairy (for production animals)
- * Horse (for production animals)
- * Sheep (for production animals)

Basically, any livestock project where production is the main focus needs to be enrolled in by early January each year.

However, be aware that a young person may join 4-H at any time of the year, but in order to show at the 4-H Shows, the above deadlines are in place.

The Great Learning Garden 4-H SPIN Club



4-H Online Enrollment

If you haven't already now is a good time to enroll or re-enroll in 4-H! The enrollment process is to be completed through the new 4-H Online 2.0, http:// v2.4honline.com. Here are some tips.

<u>Re-enrollment:</u> If you are re-enrolling, DO NOT create a new profile. You will need the email address and password you created last year. If you can't remember which email you used, please call the Extension office. If you forgot your password, just use the "Reset password?" option on the login screen. Once you make it to your "Member List" screen, simply select the youth or adult volunteer member you want to re-enroll by clicking on the "Enroll Now" next to their name. ALL adult volunteers will need to re-enroll, as well. Please edit any information that has changed. Your years in 4-H, age, and grade should have transfer correctly, but double check everything. As this is a NEW version of 4-H Online, you will have to select any and all the projects you are interested in. Unfortunately, at this time, once you've submitted your enrollment, you won't be able to add or remove projects. If you have already completed your enrollment, and need to add more projects, go ahead and contact the Extension office.

New Enrollment: If you are adding a new youth to the family or just getting started in 4-H Online for the first time and having problems contact jschiere@illinois.edu or call the Peoria Extension office at 309-685-3140 for assistance. The process of ordering 4-H manuals is different with the new 4-H Online.

- Members must enroll/re-enroll at <u>https://</u> <u>il.4honline.com</u> and then submit for approval.
- 2. County staff receive enrollment and approve each member.
- 3. Once approved, you will receive an email saying you have been approved and there will be a link to request publications. Fill out this request form for what you would like to order. **However**, it also depends on how you pay the Program Fees, on this email.

A. If you pay the program fee with a credit card, you will receive the link to order publications.

B. If you select "Pay with Check", you will not receive this link for publications until we have payment in the office.

4. Some publications are only available as a download. You will receive a separate email with the link to the download. Some downloads are free, and some have a cost. If the publication has a cost, <u>contact the Extension Office before downloading</u>.

Members that enrolled early on would not have gotten this email. The publication ordering process was not set up until just recently.
