STEM Academy

Have you ever wondered how Facebook suggests the names of friends in photos or how apps recognize the sounds of birds or the plants in your yard? STEM Academy 2021 will be looking at just those questions as we dive into the world of neural networks and machine learning (tinyML). Students will be working with an Arduino Tiny Machine Learning Kit and Edge Impulse to train the device to recognize images and sounds.

STEM Academy sessions will be June 14–18, from 10–11:30 a.m. online and are open to youth entering 6th–8th grades. Due to the limited capacity of the academy, there is an online application process. Applications are due May 17 and selected participants will be notified by May 21. Participants will pick up a kit at the University of Illinois Extension office in Peoria prior to the sessions that will include the materials they need, as well as some fun additional activities. Plus, students will keep their project at the end of the STEM Academy and will have opportunities to continue working with the platform.

4G STEM Camp

For five years, 4G STEM Camp has helped young women overcome barriers by introducing girls to careers in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math). This year, the tradition will continue with a new hybrid delivery model! 4G (Girls + Games + Gadgets = Genius) STEM camp will include five sessions of hands-on activities, experiments, and fun while local professionals offer information about their career pathways into STEM-related fields.

The program will kick off with an in-person session at the Peoria Riverfront on June 14 at 1 to 4 p.m., with appropriate safety precautions in place. Here, participants will learn about space-making on the riverfront and receive activity kits with all materials needed for the rest of the camp sessions. Virtual sessions will follow on June 16, 21, 23, and 28 from 1 to 3 p.m. Topics of these sessions will include engineering, anatomy, agriculture, art, and more!

4G STEM Camp is open to young women entering sixth, seventh, or eighth grades. The cost for participants is \$50, and fee waivers are available. Visit **<u>go.illinois.edu/4GSTEMcamp</u>** to register or learn more.

Jason Coulter Memorial Beef Award (\$500)

This award is available to current Peoria County 4-H members who are 15-18 years of age, are currently enrolled in 4-H and enrolled in the beef project for at least three years. There will be one award presented. The Jason Coulter Memorial Award will be for \$500 and paid directly to the award recipient. Once a member has been awarded the Jason Coulter Memorial award they are ineligible to reapply. Applications must be received at the Peoria County Extension office no later than July 1 of the year applying. All applicants will be required to participate in the Beef Showmanship Class the year applying and participate in a required face to face interview the Friday of the 4–H Show. The award winner will be announced in July. Sponsored by the 4–H Auction Committee.

Doris Schoenbein Memorial Scholarship Award (\$500)

All high school seniors or 4-H alumni enrolled in a junior or four year college or a trade school are eligible to apply for the Doris Schoenbein Scholarship Award regardless of future career plans.

The purpose of the award is to recognize youth for exhibiting outstanding leadership, citizenship & community service participation during their 4– H involvement. One winner will be chosen each year to receive the \$500 Doris Schoenbein Scholarship Award. This award is sponsored by the Peoria County 4–H Auction Committee to honor Doris Schoenbein for her many years of dedication as a 4–H Volunteer Leader and support of the 4–H Program.

Applications must be submitted by June 15, 2019 for consideration. The award winner will be announced in July.

Bob Forney Memorial Poultry Award (\$500)

This award is available to current Peoria County 4-H members who are 10-18 years of age, are currently enrolled in 4-H and enrolled in the poultry project. There will be one award presented. The Bob Forney Memorial Award will be for \$500 and paid directly to the award recipient. Once a member has been awarded the Bob Forney Memorial Award they are ineligible to reapply. Applications must be received at the Peoria County Extension office no later than July 1 of the year applying. All applicants will be required to participate in the Poultry Showmanship Class the year applying and participate in a required face to face interview the Friday of the 4-H Show. The award winner will be announced in July. Sponsored by the 4-H Auction Committee.

Peoria County 4-H Leadership Scholarship Award (\$100 x 2)

The 4-H Leadership Scholarship Award is for older 4-H members and 4-H Alumni (ages 17 – 21). The purpose of the award is to recognize youth for exhibiting outstanding leadership during their 4-H involvement. Two winners will be chosen each year to each receive the \$100 4-H Leadership Scholarship Award. This award is sponsored by the Peoria County 4-H Federation youth through the Peoria County 4-H Auction Committee.

Applicants must be either current 4-H members who are High School Seniors or Peoria County 4-H Alumni that are currently enrolled in an approved post High School educational program (Junior College, 4-year University, trade School, etc.)

Bob Forney Community Service Memorial Scholarship (\$200)
