Application and Eligibility

- 1. Applications and information are available at University of Illinois Extension, Pike County office, 1301 E. Washington Street, Pittsfield, Illinois 62363. They are also available on line at http://www.extension.uiuc.edu//abhps/4h/3226.html
- 2. Applicant must be accepted or enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in a college or technical school.
- 3. Student must be in good scholastic standing with at least a "C" average.
- 4. Parents or guardians of the applicant must be residents of Pike County.
- 5. The scholarship will **not** be awarded to an individual more than once.
- 6. Completed applications are due in the Pike County office by April 1st.
- 7. All applications will be held in strictest confidence by the selection committee.
- 8. All applicants must have been an active 4-H member for **four** or more years.

Selection

- 1. Selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by a committee of two representatives of the Pike County HCE Board and one from the University of Illinois Extension, Pike County office.
- 2. The selection committee will meet between April 1 and April 15 to review the applications and select the most outstanding applicant.
- 3. All applicants will be notified of the decision of the committee.
- 4. A \$250.00 scholarship in the form of a check made payable to the college they are attending will be presented to the recipient at the Pike County HCE Annual Meeting.
- 5. Selection is to be based on: commitment, personality, and character.
- 6. The recipient of the HCE scholarship must furnish a wallet size picture for a press release.
