### Application and Eligibility

1. Applications and information are available at University of Illinois Extension, Pike County office, 1301 E. Washington Street, Pittsfield, Illinois 62363. They are also available on line at <http://www.extension.uiuc.edu/abhps/4h/3226.html>
2. Applicant must be accepted or enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in a college or technical school.
3. Student must be in good scholastic standing with at least a "C" average.
4. Parents or guardians of the applicant must be residents of Pike County.
5. The scholarship will **not** be awarded to an individual more than once.
6. Completed applications are due in the Pike County office by April 1<sup>st</sup>.
7. All applications will be held in strictest confidence by the selection committee.
8. All applicants must have been an active 4-H member for **four** or more years.

### Selection

1. Selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by a committee of two representatives of the Pike County HCE Board and one from the University of Illinois Extension, Pike County office.
2. The selection committee will meet between April 1 and April 15 to review the applications and select the most outstanding applicant.
3. All applicants will be notified of the decision of the committee.
4. A \$250.00 scholarship in the form of a check made payable to the college they are attending will be presented to the recipient at the Pike County HCE Annual Meeting.
5. Selection is to be based on: commitment, personality, and character.
6. The recipient of the HCE scholarship must furnish a wallet size picture for a press release.
