Aging Referral Agencies

The following agencies provide education and referrals on a wide range of issues relevant to aging. This can include questions about food, transportation, health insurance, housing, in-home care, and more.

For the table below:

- **Benefit Access Application (BAA)**: These agencies can complete an application to help qualifying seniors get a reduced rate license plate sticker for their vehicle.
- General: These agencies provide general Information and Referral Services.
- Senior Information Services (SIS): Family Service of Champaign County currently holds the SIS contract and is the designated Single Point of Entry for all aging related questions in Champaign.
- Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP): These agencies have certified staff who can help you select the right Medicare Plan for you and your family.
- Taxes: These agencies offer free tax assistance for seniors in Champaign County

Ways to Save on Medications

- 1. Ask your pharmacist or physician if there are less expensive versions or generic options.
- 2. If the medication is not on your "approved" coverage list, ask if there is a similar drug on the "formulary" that could be used instead.
- 3. Ask if there is medication financial assistance through your health provider.
- 4. Contact the drug manufacturer to see if there is a medication discount card for seniors or those with disabilities. These cards can offer significant savings.
- 5. If you use Medicare, consult with a SHIP counselor to ensure you are on the right Part D Plan.

Food, Meals, Nutrition

The following locations can assist you if you need help keeping your pantry stocked or managing your nutrition. Food delivery agencies may provide grocery deliveries and/or pre-made meals delivered to your doorstep. Food banks offer free food to those in need. Congregate meal sites offer a safe space to enjoy a hot meal in a community setting for little or no fee. Nutritional counseling can help you make informed decisions about what you eat.





Insurance

Medicare & Medicaid Info

 <u>Medicare</u> is the government health insurance program

serving people who are 65 and older or those who are permanently disabled or in End Stage Renal Disease.

- You **must** sign up for Parts B and D when you are eligible or Social Security will assess you a monthly fine.
 - Part A: hospitalization, skilled nursing care, and hospice
 - Part B: outpatient services, doctor appointments, and ambulance services
 - Part A & B: cover some home health costs.
 - Part D Prescription Drug Plan: Everyone with Medicare is eligible for this coverage to help with brand name and generic prescriptions. There is extra help for those with limited income.
- Part C, known as Medicare Advantage, is a privately offered Medicare alternative. These plans bundle all coverage from Parts A and B with features such as dental or vision, and often include Part D coverage.
 - Managed care plans such as Health Maintenance Organizations (HMOs), Preferred Provider Organizations (PPOs) and Medical Savings Accounts (MSAs)
- <u>Medicaid</u> is a state and federal health insurance program for people with low income and limited assets. Medicaid covers medical and long-term care services. It covers prescription medications and nursing home care. In some cases, with prior authorization and approvals it may cover glasses, dental work, and hearing aids.

Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP)

SHIP is a free statewide health insurance counseling service for Medicare beneficiaries and their caregivers. Many local agencies have SHIP Counselors who can help you choose the right Medicare plans and/or apply for Medicare.

SPECTRUM OF CARE

There may come a time when you or a loved one needs additional support to complete day-to-day tasks. Spectrum of Care refers to the range of supportive options available to help you, both in and out of your home setting.

Adult Day Services

Adult Day Service provides a safe environment during the day for those who need health monitoring, supervision, socialization and want to remain independent in their own homes. Adult Day Services provide meals, socialization opportunities, exercise, medical monitoring, recreation, and therapeutic activities for the mind and body.

Palliative and Hospice Care

These services are offered to patients near the end of life to help manage and monitor a terminal illness.

- <u>Palliative Care</u> provides illness oversight, medication management, and symptom monitoring while a patient continues to seek curative treatments (i.e. physical and occupational therapy, chemo, etc.).
- <u>Hospice Care</u> provides expanded medical support for patients with an anticipated life expectancy of 6 months and are no longer seeking curative treatment. Hospice will bring in medical equipment like a hospital bed or bedside commode, will pick-up and deliver medications, and will monitor all medical care so families can focus on being family in the final days.

Housing

There are many different types of housing available with different pricing structures, insurance ability, and levels of care. Making the decision to transition is different for every family and can take time. If you need any insight, you may contact any of the Aging Referral Agencies or Assisted Living Helpers, an agency dedicated to helping families guide them through the search. Retirement Community (RC)

A residential community or housing complex designed for older adults who are generally able to care for themselves.

Independent Living (IL)

Residential options for older adults who are living on their own while taking advantage of various amenities and community offerings.

Low-Income Senior Housing (L-ISH)

Apartments that gear towards older persons who can live independently and do their own personal care and meal preparation. Income qualification for residents in financial need.

Rehabilitation (Rehab)

Following discharge from the hospital, doctors may recommend staying in a certified rehab facility for a short period of time while you rest and recover with trained professional oversight.

Assisted Living (AL)

Housing for older persons that provides nursing care, housekeeping, social opportunities and prepared meals as needed.

Supportive Living (SL)

Supportive Living is the Medicaid-supported model of Assisted Living.

Memory Care (MC)

Housing for older persons with memory loss that provides nursing care, housekeeping, social opportunities and prepared meals as needed. Typically require a diagnosis of some form of dementia.

Skilled Nursing / Nursing Homes (SN/NH)

A residential facility providing long term personal or nursing care for persons who are unable to care for themselves at home. Short term rehab and inpatient therapy services may also be provided.

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In-Home Caregiver Support

Paid professionals are trained to provide support for you and your loved one in the comfort of your home in an effort to keep you safe and independent at home, to avoid hospitalization or delay facility placement, and are tailored to your personal needs.

Home Care

Consists of nonmedical services provided in the home for clients who have difficulty managing their activities of daily living. Home care aides, hired privately or through an agency, may help with activities such as homemaking (cleaning and organization), transportation, medication management and reminders, companion visits, meal preparation, help with dressing, toileting, bathing, transportation services, and companionship.

Home Health Care

Consists of formal medical support provided by a licensed professional in the home. This can include nurses, physical, occupational or speech therapists, respiratory therapy, and social workers. They can administer medications, IVs, shots, and conduct medical tests and monitoring. Home care aides can assist with personal care only if licensed professionals are working in the home.
