The official move date is the last week of August. The office will be closed on Tuesday, August 27 for the move. Please be patient while we get settled into our new home.



End of Year Awards

Whether you are a first-year 4-H member or a longtime member, it's time to focus on pulling together information for your 4-H award applications. Even younger members can submit the 4-H Experience Application and be eligible for 4-H recognition. Older members can submit both the 4-H Experience Application and the Illinois 4-H Award Application to be eligible for state recognition, scholarships, and/or trips.



The Illinois 4-H Experience Award Application focuses on all of those events and activities that you have experienced during the 4-H year in four areas: Participation, Community Service, Leadership, and Project Learning. Depending upon the type and number of experiences you can report on, members can receive recognition on the Bronze, Silver, Gold, Diamond or Emerald Clover Award level. Your family calendar, 4-H notes or county summary, checkmarks, and a few written details are all that's needed for even the youngest members to submit this application. All county award applications are due October 1.



The deadline for State Award applications is moving up from early January to October 15. Be sure to start filling out applications early. This applies to State 4-H awards, Key Award, Legacy of Leadership awards, and the Diamond/Emerald level experience awards. Fillable versions of all the applications can be found at the link above.
