- 2) The *Visitor Center/Griinke Creamery* building is styled after the *Griinke Creamery* that was once on the property. What was Mr. Griinke's first name? (Hint: answer is on the plaque on the building.)
- 3) What years did the Beckman family live in the *Cooperage/Beckman Home*?
- 4) What is the Beckman family home used for now?
- 5) What does the bench in "A Mother's Garden" say?
- 6) There is a sign in the *Heritage Garden*. What did Charlie and Bessie Beckman grow in the garden?
- 7) Find the plaque on *Beckman Mill*. What year was the mill built?
- 8) Who built *Beckman Mill*?
- 9) What year did *Beckman Mill* celebrate its 150th anniversary?
- 10) Who is the *Griinke Bridge* (the footbridge) in memory of?
- 11) What is the name of the creek where *Beckman Mill* is?
