The objective of the Hancock County 4-H Foundation scholarship program is to provide scholarships to college bound students who have been active Hancock County 4-H members. These scholarships are awarded on the basis of exceptional scholastic ability, involvement in 4-H, community service, and/or financial need. Previous scholarship winners are not eligible to apply.

Applicants must meet all eligibility guidelines, including:

- Be a high school senior or high school graduate;
- Be an active Hancock County 4-H member at time of application.

The criteria for awarding the scholarships are as follows:

- Scholarship and academic performance
- Demonstrate involvement in 4-H and community service
- Character and personality

Applications must be submitted at <https://form.jotform.com/223144538599062> by midnight on March 31, 2023, along with an uploaded digital photo (to be used in promotional material), and an official transcript.
