Quality Assurance & Ethics Certification (QAEC)

QAEC training is mandatory for all *horse, rabbit, poultry, and companion animal* projects.

All county and state exhibitors must complete QAEC via this site <u>once</u> during their showing career. Those that have completed it in the past do not have to complete it again.


Thank you to our 4-H volunteers for helping at the 2024 Steer Weigh-In. We had five steers that weighed in.




