- 1. Review the following:
 - A. Showbook Rules/Guidelines

Entry deadlines have been adjusted due to virtual show.

Any member that is enrolled and paid their county enrollment fee is eligible to show, the previous requirement to attend 4 events has been waived for this year.

- 2. Enter Project into Fair Entry
 - A. Declare class
 - B. Where noted add Date of Birth, Declared Weight and Breed
- 3. Record Videos of Projects

Include Date of Birth, Weight and Breed using <u>Live Animal Entry Template</u>

Print in black marker and hold up to camera for the first 5-10 seconds so judge can see the information.

- 4. Upload videos to Box File, deadline to upload is July 16.
- 6. Champions and show results will be announce by August 1.
