The Impact of Time on Money		
Age	Contributions Made Early	Contributions Made Later
22-30 (9 years)	\$2,000 annually	\$0
31-65 (35 years)	\$0	\$2,000 annually
Total Saved	\$18,000	\$70,000
Amount available at 65	\$579,471*	\$470,249*
