- Complete online enrollments for 2024 2025. Opens October 1, 2024. 4h.zsuite.org
- Pay the annual Program Fee (\$20/member; \$10/member if I register and pay before midnight on November 30)



- Choose at least 1 project
- Order my project books at go.illinois.edu/FMPTPubs
- **Give a talk/demonstration** to my club about one of my projects
- If doing a Public Speaking or a live animal project, watch my email for important additional details
- If doing a live animal project, complete ethics training
 - YQCA required <u>annually</u> if exhibiting Beef, Dairy, Goats, Sheep, or Swine
 - QAEC required <u>once</u> if exhibiting Cats, Dogs, Horses, Poultry, or Rabbits
 - Must be completed by July 15



- Attend at least 1 club meeting (Parents are encouraged to attend meetings and volunteer when the leader needs help)
- Read the newsletter and watch email for important information
- Like us on Facebook to see announcements and reminders



- Prepare for show dates (July 2025).
 exhibitors must be present for in-person judging. Tazewell County 4-H Show dates are July 28, 29, 30, 2025
- Read the exhibit requirements for my projects in the show book, which is made available to families in the spring
- Register which of my projects I plan to exhibit. Being enrolled in a project does not automatically mean you will exhibit it, so registration is required in FairEntry. Deadline is July 1, 2025
- Prepare my exhibits Parents and mentors can guide and assist with project work, but members are expected to complete their exhibits themselves
