The Tazewell County 4-H Public Speaking Contest will take place during the last week of March in the Tazewell Extension office (the exact date is being finalized). Members enrolled in this project will be contacted directly with specific details. The Illinois State 4-H Public Speaking Contest is scheduled for Saturday, April 30 at Parkland College in Champaign.

Illinois Pork Premiere Requirements

- Farrowed **on or after February 10, 2022.** Both purebred and crossbred pigs are eligible.
- Each exhibitor may nominate a maximum of twentyfive barrows at the time of tattooing.
- Pigs must be castrated before they are tattooed.
- Barrows must be nominated, ear notched and tattooed before they are 35 days old.
- Pigs cannot weigh more than the equivalent of 1.0 pound per day of age when tattooed.
- All pigs must be tattooed by April 15, 2022.
- If premiere barrows are properly nominated, ownership can be transferred to purchaser for exhibition if ownership deadlines are adhered to.
- To have your pigs tattooed, please contact the Tazewell Extension office to schedule a date and time.

April 15, 2022: Horse & Pony ID & Lease Forms— Tazewell County 4-H members planning to exhibit their horse/pony at the 4-H Show and Jr. Fair are required to complete an ID form and Ownership or Lease papers and turn in a copy of their current Coggins test to the Extension office by April 15. Packets will be mailed out to members after March 1.

July 1, 2022: 4-H Show Registration—ALL Tazewell County 4-H members planning on exhibiting at the 2022 Tazewell 4-H Show & Jr. Fair will need to register for their eligible exhibit opportunities by July 1.

Lambs & Goats for Illinois State Fair

Lambs for the 2022 Illinois State Fair Junior and Open Premiere (carcass) Shows must be, nominated, weighed, and tattooed, between (including) March 15 and May 15, 2022 at the local county level. Please contact the Tazewell Extension office to schedule a date and time

Non-Premiere lambs and goats for state fair (those showing in the live show only)

All non-premiere lambs and goats for state fair junior show will be Self-Nominated in 2022 as follows:

- Exhibitors fill out and send in nomination form with photo of lamb's ear with scrapie tag installed in ear (closeup photo of ear so scrapie tag can be read). Nominations must be signed by local Extension Office.
- This must be completed between March 15 and May 15, 2022.
- Contact the Tazewell Extension office for the form and assistance.
