### What is All My Money?

All My Money: Change for the Better is a train-the-trainer financial management program for persons working with limited-resource audiences. It is designed so that agency staff, social workers, and other educators can teach financial literacy topics, even if they do not personally have expertise in financial management.

### Does All My Money offer face to face training?

Yes! Trainees will learn about financial management & develop facilitation skills. They will experience a hands-on, experiential approach through the eight lessons of the curriculum.

### What do I get if I register for a training?

Two days of instruction with an author of the curriculum. A hard copy of the complete curriculum in a 3-ring binder. A USB flash drive with all files in PDF form. Plus, the resource box containing all of the reusable materials for activities. Training fee is \$230/person, 2 people from the same organization can share the materials for an additional \$115.
