1. Members are encouraged to create a uniquely designed entry. One entry per member allowed.

2. Entry should be 4-H audience appropriate.

3. Pinecone(s) must be decorated at home and picture submitted to <u>https://go.illinois.edu/PH4HPinecone</u>

4. Deadline to submit entries is December 23rd at 4 PM.

5. Do not include your name on your pinecone(s) or in your photo.

6. No more than 5 pinecones can be used to create your entry. Pinecone(s) can be humorous, beautiful, abstract, or natural, use your imagination.

7. Age groups are Cloverbuds (5-7), Junior (8-12), and Senior (13-18). Age groups may be combined if not enough participants per age division.

8. PINECONES MUST BE ORIGINAL (CREATED BY 4-H MEMBER). NO PINECONES BOUGHT PRE-PAINTED OR ALREADY DECORATED WILL BE ACCEPTED! 4-H MEMBER MAY BE SUPERVISED FOR SAFETY PERCAUTIONS.
