

Secretary


- Keeps an accurate record of all meetings

4-H Pumpkin Contest

4-H in our county is an incredible experience. We need to let the public know that we are here, active, and excited for the new year! There's no better way to do this, than to make sure that our activities are front and center in our communities. With this in mind, all Pope and Hardin County 4-H members are invited to participate in a Pumpkin Contest this year! Contest guidelines are as follows:

- 1. Members may only enter one pumpkin.
- 2. Pumpkins should be 4-H audience appropriate.
- 3. Pumpkins must be decorated at home and brought to the Extension office completed.
- 4. Pumpkins should be delivered to the U of I Extension office on October 26th or 27th. Times for drop off are the hours of 8:30-4.
- 5. Pumpkins must be easy to transport.
- 6. Do not put your name on your pumpkin, place your entry form upside down under your pumpkin.
- 7. Pumpkins can be painted, decorated, "dressed up" or a combination of these. CARVED PUMPKINS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 8. Categories include: Scariest, Funniest, and Most Creative. Age groups are Cloverbuds (5-7), Junior (8-12), and Senior (13-18). Age groups may be combined if not enough participants per age division.
- 9. <u>PUMPKINS MUST BE ORIGINAL (CREATED BY 4-H MEMBER). NO PUMPKINS BOUGHT PRE-PAINTED,</u> <u>CARVED OR ALREADY DECORATED WILL BE ACCEPTED!</u>




4-H Hike
