Public Presentations

Public Speakers, Food Demonstrators, Demonstrators and Flower Arrangers

Saline County 4-H Public Presentations Contest will be held on Monday, April 12, 2021 at 6:00 pm at the Extension office in Harrisburg. We may have to schedule appointment times. I will know more when I see how many speakers and demonstrators register.

Members participating in this contest must have enrolled in their project (Public Speaking, Foods, Floriculture or other project area relating to your demonstration) by March 31. Email Nancy at nlambert@illinois.edu to let me know what you the type of demonstration you plan to do or the type and name of your speech by the March 29.

Food demonstrators are reminded to bring their foods in a cooler, as there will be no refrigerator available. Also, bring an extension cord if you need electricity for your speech or demonstration.

The State 4-H Public Speaking Event will be held on June 5 at Richland Community College in Decatur, IL. This includes the 4 speech areas: Formal, Illustrated, Original Works, and Oral Interpretation.

QAEC

Exhibitors of horses, poultry, rabbits, dogs, and cats are required to take the **Quality Assurance and Ethics Certification** (QAEC) training. QAEC training is only required once in the member's career and is offered free of charge. Please visit: http://web.extension.illinois.edu/gaec/ to take the training.

Swine Weigh-In

The Saline County 4-H Swine Weigh-In will be held on Saturday, **April 10** at **1:00 pm** at the Fairgrounds. 4-H members enrolled in Market Swine projects who want to participate in the Swine Rate of Gain Contest should plan to attend.



840 tags may be substituted for A tags or B tags in Swine Projects. If they are being used in place of A tags (at weigh -in) the 840 tag must be in the animal's ear prior to weigh-in. If they are being used in place of B tags, the 840 tag must be placed in the ear and the number reported to the Extension office within 10 days of the weigh-in.

Lamb & Meat Goat Weigh-In

The Saline County 4-H Lamb and Meat Goat Weigh-Ins will be held on Saturday, **April 24** at **1:00 pm** at the Fairgrounds. 4-H members enrolled in Market Sheep or Meat Goat projects who want to participate in the Saline County Rate of Gain Contests should plan to attend.

Since Covid-19 numbers are down and restrictions are loosening, we will not have to take appointments. For both weigh-ins and the YQCA trainings below, please understand that we still need to limit our numbers to 50 or less, wear a face covering at all times, and practice social distancing. We will let you know if anything changes.

YQCA CERTIFICATION

4-H members exhibiting **Beef Cattle, Swine, Dairy Cattle, Goat, or Sheep** will be required to complete the **Youth for the Quality Care of Animals** certification (YQCA). This statewide certification must be completed annually. **Youth MUST complete this training prior to the Saline County 4-H livestock shows.** This does not apply to youth exhibiting animal or veterinary science poster projects.

We have a face-to-face training scheduled for Saturday, April 24th, at 2 pm at the Saline County Fairgrounds following the Lamb/Goat Weigh-ins. The training will take approximately 1 hour. We can have up to 50 youth. Go online to register and pay the \$3 fee by April 17th.

A Big Thank You to the Saline County Stockmen's Association. They have generously offered to reimburse the \$3 to all those who register and attend this training.

For those unable to train at this time, a second face-to-face training will be held at the White County Fairgrounds in Carmi on Saturday, May 1, from 9-10 am.

Dog Obedience & Agility Classes Begin On APRIL 27

Dog Obedience, Showmanship, and Agility classes will begin on Tuesday, April 27. Classes will be held at instructor Cheri White's Shop at 613 W. Elm St. in Harrisburg. Classes will continue each Tuesday for 11 weeks, concluding on Tuesday, July 13.

On April 27th, **first year exhibitors** should arrive at **6 pm** for an introduction to the course. **Bring your dog's shot records, but leave your dog at home.** Exhibitors attending classes for their second year or more should arrive at

7 pm with their dogs and shot records. If you have questions about these classes, please call Cheri White at 926-0787.

Face coverings and social distancing are required for all participants and spectators.

The **Dog Agility 4-H Show** will be held at **Cheri White's** on **Tuesday, July 20 at 7 pm.** Dog Care, Obedience, and Showmanship - along with Cat Care - will be held on **Thursday, July 22** at **6 pm** at the Fairgrounds.

Horse & Pony Validation Forms Due May 1

Saline County 4-H Horse & Pony Project Validation Forms (along with photos of your horse if you plan to show at State Fair) will be due in to the Extension office no later than May 1. You will need to fill out one copy per horse that you may possibly bring to the show.

All Exhibitors must have a completed **4-H Lifetime Release from Liability** form on file at the Extension office. **Helmets are required for all 4-H Horse & Pony mounted exhibitors in or out of the show ring.**

Rabbit Tattooing Opportunity

Saline County Rabbit exhibitors are invited to come out to the Saline County Fairgrounds on Saturday, May 8, 2021 from 10 am to Noon to get your rabbits tattooed for the Saline County 4-H Rabbit Show in July.

Remember...your rabbits and their information, including the tattoo, need to be recorded on the Livestock Registration Sheet and turned in by May 15th.
