2021 Livestock Ownership Deadlines

Birth, Ownership and Tattoo Dates for Illinois State Fair Junior Show and White County. If you are interested in State Fair, please ask for more specific guidelines.

STEERS & MARKET HEIFERS:

- Calved on or after January 1, 2020

- Owned & personally cared for by exhibitor since February 1, 2021
- Tattooed & Tagged –
- On or between the last Saturday in January (January 30, 2021) and February 28, 2021.

Beef weigh-in is February 6. (All Male & Females will be weighed and/or tagged)

o In addition to tattooing, steers that will be going to state fair are to be tagged with the electronic ID tags.

BARROWS:

- Regular Barrows

o Farrowed on or after January 1, 2021 and must be the property of the exhibitor by June 1, 2021.

Swine weigh-in is March 27 @ 9am @ the Fairgrounds

(All Male & Females will be weighed and/or tagged)

- Premiere Barrows

o **Farrowed on or after February 10, 2021** and must have been the property of the exhibitor by June 1, 2021

- o Weighed and Tattooed February 10 to April 15, 2021
- o Tattooed within 35 days of birth and not weigh more than 1.0lbs/day of age
- o Junior exhibitors can purchase nominated barrows

SHEEP WETHERS:

- Both Premiere & Live Show Wethers

o Lambed on or after January 1, 2021

o Ownership Date – May 15, 2021

o Weighed, Tattooed & Tagged – between March 15 and May 16, 2021.

Sheep & Goat weigh-in is May 1 @ 8:00am @ Fairgrounds.

(All Male & Females will be weighed and/or tagged)

- Weigh/Tattoo procedures for Open & Jr. Premiere & Live Show Wethers:

All lambs and meat goats to be exhibited at the State Fair MUST be taken to one of the statewide locations for weighing and tattooing. Each lamb will be tagged with an electronic ID tag, tattooed, weighed, and recorded on Lamb Nomination Forms from Dan Jennings.

Specific information regarding each of the weigh-in locations & procedures will be forthcoming. MEAT GOATS

- Wethers – Born on or after October 1, 2020

- Tattooed in name of exhibitor only by May 15, 2021
- Ownership dates for Kids & Yearlings not in milk May 15, 2021

HORSE: Ownership deadline-May 1, 2021

We strongly encourage members, if they own or lease more than one horse, to file paperwork on ALL potential exhibit horses by the deadline. If a horse is injured or dies, it may be replaced ONLY by a horse whose paperwork is already on file by the deadline. A horse may only be owned or leased to, and exhibited by ONE 4-H or FFA member at the State Fair Junior Horse Show. Download the form @ https://4h.extension.illinois.edu/members/projects/horse.

Registration forms were given at cattle and swine weigh-in, in this newsletter, and on our website. They are to be returned to the Extension Office by May 15th, or you will be unable to sell at the auction.





YQCA Certificatio<mark>n</mark>

Attention Beef Cattle, Swine, Dairy Cattle, Goat, and Sheep Exhibitors!

4-H members exhibiting animals entering the food production system will be required to complete the Youthfor the Quality Care of Animals certification (YQCA). This statewide certification is the industry-standard and must be completed annually. Youth MUST complete this training prior to the White County 4-H livestock shows. This does not apply to youth exhibiting animal or veterinary science poster projects.

Two face-to-face trainings will be offered, April 24 at the Saline Co. Fairgrounds and May 1 following the sheep/goat weigh-in at the White Co. Fairgrounds. Registration is required for the face-to-face trainings with a cost of \$3.

Youth are encouraged to visit: <u>http://yqca.org</u> to certify or re-certify. The cost is \$12.

QAEC Certification



Exhibitors of horses, poultry, rabbits, dogs, and cats will still be required to take the Quality Assurance and Ethics (QAEC) training. QAEC training is only required once in the member's career and isoffered free of charge.

All Market Animals (including beef, sheep, and goat) <u>not</u> weighed in and tattooed at weigh-ins must be tattooed and reported to the office <u>within 10 days</u> of the weigh-in. They will have to be ear notched/tagged and written on this sheet. UNDER THESE CIRCUMSTANC-ES WE UNDERSTAND THERE MIGHT NOT BE A WEIGH-IN. WE WILL WORK THROUGH THAT TOGETHER!

NOTICE: Pens will be assigned by Amy and/or the Livestock Superintendents this year. Please state the minimum number of pens you will need for each species.
