YQCA Certification


Attention Beef Cattle, Swine, Dairy Cattle, Goat, and Sheep Exhibitors!

4-H members exhibiting animals entering the food production system will be required to complete the Youth for the Quality Care of Animals certification (YQCA). This statewide certification is the industry-standard and must be completed annually. Youth MUST complete this training prior to the White County 4-H livestock shows. This does not apply to youth exhibiting animal or veterinary science poster projects.






