

# EVANSVILLE VETERANS CENTER

Cookable food for shelters and homes: spaghetti noodles, pasta sauce, mac and cheese, oatmeal, large boxes of saltines.

<u>Toiletries</u>: Shampoo/body wash combos, razors, shaving cream, bar soap, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrushes, hand sanitizer, body wipes. The VA clinic also provides clothing items for vets and the best way for them to do this is to have WALMART gift cards. Also, Thorton's gas cards.
