2022 Livestock Ownership Deadlines

Birth, Ownership and Tattoo Dates for Illinois State Fair Junior Show and White County. If you are interested in State Fair, please ask for more specific guidelines.

STEERS & MARKET HEIFERS:

- Calved on or after January 1, 2021
- Owned & personally cared for by exhibitor since February 1, 2022
- Tattooed & Tagged -
- o On or between the last Saturday in January (January 29, 2022) and February 27, 2022.
- o In addition to tattooing, steers that will be going to state fair are to be tagged with the electronic ID tags.

BARROWS:

- Regular Barrows
- o Farrowed on or after December 15, 2021 (White County Livestock Show Only) and must be the property of the exhibitor by June 1, 2022.
- Premiere Barrows
- o Farrowed on or after February 10, 2022 and must have been the property of the exhibitor by June 1, 2022
- o Weighed and Tattooed February 10 to April 15, 2022
- o Tattooed within 35 days of birth and not weigh more than 1.0lbs/day of age
- o Junior exhibitors can purchase nominated barrows

SHEEP WETHERS:

- Both Premiere & Live Show Wethers
- o Lambed on or after January 1, 2022
- o Ownership Date May 15, 2022
- o Weighed, Tattooed & Tagged between March 15 and May 15, 2022.

Sheep & Goat weigh-in is May 7 @ 8:00am @ Fairgrounds.

(All Male & Females will be weighed and/or tagged)

- Weigh/Tattoo procedures for Open & Jr. Premiere & Live Show Wethers:

All lambs and meat goats to be exhibited at the State Fair MUST be taken to one of the statewide locations for weighing and tattooing. Each lamb will be tagged with an electronic ID tag, tattooed, weighed, and recorded on Lamb Nomination Forms from Dan Jennings.

Specific information regarding each of the weigh-in locations & procedures will be forthcoming.

MEAT GOATS

- Wethers Born on or after October 1, 2021
- Tattooed in name of exhibitor only by May 15, 2022
- Ownership dates for Kids & Yearlings not in milk May 15, 2022

HORSE: Ownership deadline—May 1, 2021

We strongly encourage members, if they own or lease more than one horse, to file paperwork on ALL potential exhibit horses by the deadline. **If a horse is injured or dies, it may be replaced ONLY by a horse whose paperwork is already on file by the deadline.** A horse may only be owned or leased to, and exhibited by ONE 4-H or FFA member at the State Fair Junior Horse Show. Registration forms were given at cattle and swine weigh-in, in this newsletter, and on our website. They are to be returned to the Extension Office by May 16th, or you will be unable to sell at the auction.

Re-certification required for youth exhibiting livestock

4-H members exhibiting animals entering the food production system will be required to complete the **Youth for the Quality Care of Animal** certification (YQCA). This program is the industry-standard certification. Check with local offices about completing the training.

The training must be completed each year. yqcaprogram.org

Horses, rabbits, poultry, dogs, and cats will still be required to take the **Quality Assurance and Ethics** (QAEC) training. This training is only required once in the member's career.



College in Fairfield to get his general studies.


While he is currently undecided on a career, he enjoys photography and videography and hopes to incorporate this into his future plans.

All Market Animals (including beef, sheep, and goat) not weighed in and tattooed at weigh-ins must be tattooed and reported to the office within 10 days of the weigh-in. They will have to be ear notched/tagged and written on this sheet.

NOTICE: Pens will be assigned by Amy and/or the Livestock Superintendents this year. Please state the minimum number of pens you will need for each species.
