Ethics Requirements for 2019-2020

Youth enrolled in horses, poultry, rabbits, cats & dogs:

Youth enrolled in beef, sheep, swine, and goats:

2. **In Person** - We will offer one in-person training per county in the winter/spring. Cost of certification through this method is \$3, but it will only certify you for one year.

<u>Note:</u> This requirement only applies to youth planning to show a *live* animal at any show - county, state, regional, or national. It does not apply to youth exhibiting a poster related to an animal.
