## IT'S TIME TO MAKE THOSE FAIR ENTRIES

### Reminders in fair entry:

- In Fair Entry you must answer this question at the very start to proceed to add exhibits.  
**"As a 4-H member and family, we agree to follow the safety guidelines outlined for 4-H events, which include the requirement to wear a mask in both indoor and outdoor exhibit venues. I also understand that Illinois 4-H reserves the right to adjust or cancel events in the case of identified risk, such as changes in local COVID conditions or known instances of non-compliance with safety guidelines."** AGREE or DISAGREE
- If are exhibiting a general (non-livestock) project. You will need to answer this question for each exhibit.  
**"Conference judging is not a requirement. You may conference if you wish. We recommend conferencing only 1-3 projects. You will be assigned a conferencing time. Will you be conferencing this project?"** YES or NO
- If you see this message, you have not answered one or more of these questions. Click on the blue box, answer the question, and you should be able to proceed.

There is 1 item that needs your attention

Review/Complete Outstanding Records

- Password Reset
  - If you are attempting to make an entry for the fair in Fair Entry, and you have forgotten your password, you will need to reset the password in [4-HOnline 2.0](#) and not in Fair Entry.

## QAEC or YQCA?????



Still wandering if you need to attend the YQCA or QAEC training??? Here is a breakdown of who needs to be certified in these trainings.

- **QAEC:** This online training is for those 4-H members who are exhibiting in poultry, rabbits, horses, dog or cat. This training is a ONE TIME training for your whole 4-H career. Check with Tanya (hetelle@illinois.edu) if you want to make sure you have done this training. Website is:

- **YQCA:** This training is for those 4-H members who are exhibiting in cattle, swine, sheep and/or goats. This training is a YEARLY training.
