





Which grocery store closure has impacted you the most?




How did the closing of the Carrollton Kroger impact your ability to get the groceries you need?






What did you purchase on a regular basis from the Carrollton Kroger? Check all that apply




How did the closing of the White Hall Kroger impact your ability to get the groceries you need?






What did you purchase on a regular basis from the White Hall Kroger? Check all that apply




How did the closing of the Carrollton IGA impact your ability to get the groceries you need?



What did you like most about the Carrollton IGA?
















Which race best describes you?




Ethnicity?




