Important Reminders:

- Every 4-H'er will be required to attend FOUR 4-H meetings this year in order to show at the fair. This can be club meetings or workshops that the extension office hosts.
- Don't forget to RE-ENROLL! You must be re-enrolled in 4-H by January 1,2022. New members have till March 1,2022 to enroll.
- You will have till March 1st to change your projects if you choose to add or delete a 4-H project. You can do this my going into your 4-H online account or contacting our office.
- Livestock Ownership deadlines will be released soon from the state. The first one will be steers. If you are planning to show a steer at the fair you must have ownership of those by January 1,2022.

What are publications?

Publications are guide books that allow you to gain skills on your projects. Some projects require the publication in order to complete your project for fair and for some project areas the publications aren't really needed. If you need help making this decision please reach out to Megan.

Remember to only order the books you NEED!

If you have books from the past couple of years that you would like to donate back to the extension office so we can re-use them please drop them by!

This year we will be using a online form to order your publications. Everyone needs to have their publication orders in **January 1st, 2022**. Once the publications arrive at our office we will contact you or deliver them to your club meetings.

As soon as I have the handbook and fair schedule finalized and approved by the state I will release that to you all. But as many are getting their fair animals ready I wanted to let you know of this change.
