Quality Assurance & Ethics

This is mandatory for all FIRST TIME horse, rabbit, poultry, and companion animals. The website is now open. Those that have completed it in the past do not have to complete it again.

Animal Identification

Pigs: All pigs will need to be tagged. The extension office will provide the tags for you. You will need to email us or call the office to get those tags. Once the tags are in the pigs ears you will need to submit 2 pictures. 1) A picture of the front of the pig where the tag can be seen 2) a profile picture of the pig. You will need to submit these photos along with the pig ownership form.

DEADLINE: June 1st, 2021

Sheep: Each sheep is required to have an identification tag. If you do not have one we have tags available at the office. You will also need to submit 2 pictures to the extension office. 1) A picture of the front of the sheep where the tag can be seen 2) a profile picture of the sheep. You will need to submit these photos along with the sheep ownership form.

DEADLINE: May 15th, 2021

Goats: If your goat has an identification number tag then you can use that. If not, we have tags available at the office. You will also need to submit 2 pictures to the extension office. 1) A picture of the front of the goat where the tag can be seen 2) a profile picture of the goat. You will need to submit these photos along with the goat ownership form.

DEADLINE: May 15th, 2021

REQUIREMENTS: Youth ages 12-18 (some programs 15-18)


