Guidelines for Wayne County 4-H Scholarship

Wayne County 4-H Foundation has set these guidelines for seniors applying for the 4-H Scholarship. This is to assure that the awards go to outstanding 4-H members.

Guidelines are:

1. The applicant must be an active 4-H member the year of application.
2. Applicant must be a member of a Wayne County 4-H club and attend Cisne, Fairfield or Wayne City High School.
3. The applicant must be a member in good standing the current year and the two previous years of the application. A member in good standing consists of: 1. Attend a minimum of 4 club meetings, 2. Give a talk or demonstration at club meeting, 3. Exhibit a project at the county 4-H show, and 4. Complete year-end records.
4. If there is not a qualified applicant from a school district, an additional scholarship may be awarded to another school district.
5. Scholarship money will be awarded after 4-H year-end records and requirements are met and proof of college enrollment is submitted to the Wayne County Extension Office. If requirements are not met, the scholarship will be awarded to an alternate.
6. 2 Letters of Recommendation in a sealed envelope.
7. Scholarship criteria will be scored as follows:

Years in 4-H	1 point per year (max 10 points)
Experiences in 4-H	
4-H projects	10 points
4-H Offices held	10 points
4-H citizenship/leadership experience	20 points
Citizenship/leadership outside of 4-H	20 points
Impact	20 points
Neatness & appearance	<u>10 points</u>
Total Points	100

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
