FAVORITE SNAP-Ed RECIPE: Hamburger Skillet Dinner

1 lb. ground beef, lean 1/2 cup water 1 small onion, chopped 1 potato, peeled and sliced 1 cup celery, diced 2 tomatoes, diced, or 1 can (15 oz.) diced tomatoes, drained 1/2 teaspoon black pepper

1/4 cup low-sodium soy sauce 1 large green pepper, cut into thin strips 2 cup cabbage, chopped 1 teaspoon garlic powder

Preparation

1) In a large skillet or pot, brown beef and onion. Drain excess fat. 2) Add rest of ingredients to skillet or pot. 3) Cover and cook on high for 1-2 minutes. 4) Reduce heat and cook slowly (simmer) for 15 minutes. Nutrition facts available on eat-move-save.extension.illinois.edu
